

REAL MOMENTUM ► MEASURABLE RESULTS

In 2007, Texans voted overwhelmingly to create the Cancer Prevention and Research Institute of Texas (CPRIT) to invest \$3 billion in Texas research capabilities, create and expand Texas life science infrastructure, and expedite innovation in cancer prevention and cures. **Benefits to Texas include:**

INVESTING IN THE RESEARCH CAPABILITIES OF TEXAS UNIVERSITIES

- **181 stellar researchers** and their labs recruited to Texas institutions
- Texas achieved **3 NCI comprehensive cancer centers** - previously only MD Anderson Cancer Center
- **\$1.1 billion** in direct follow-on funding raised by CPRIT academic grantees
- **51 CPRIT core facilities** to provide access to cutting-edge shared technology through capital instrumentation and technical expertise

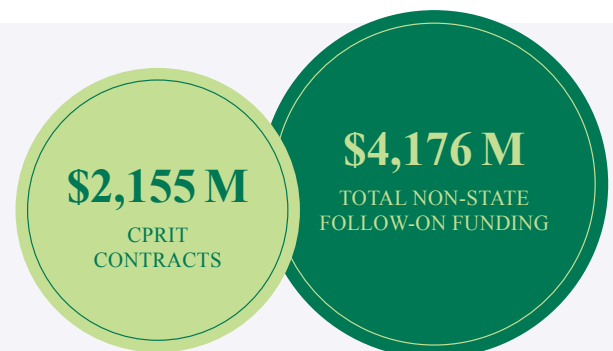
EXPANDING THE LIFE SCIENCE INFRASTRUCTURE BY ATTRACTING COMPANIES TO TEXAS AND CREATING HIGH-QUALITY NEW JOBS

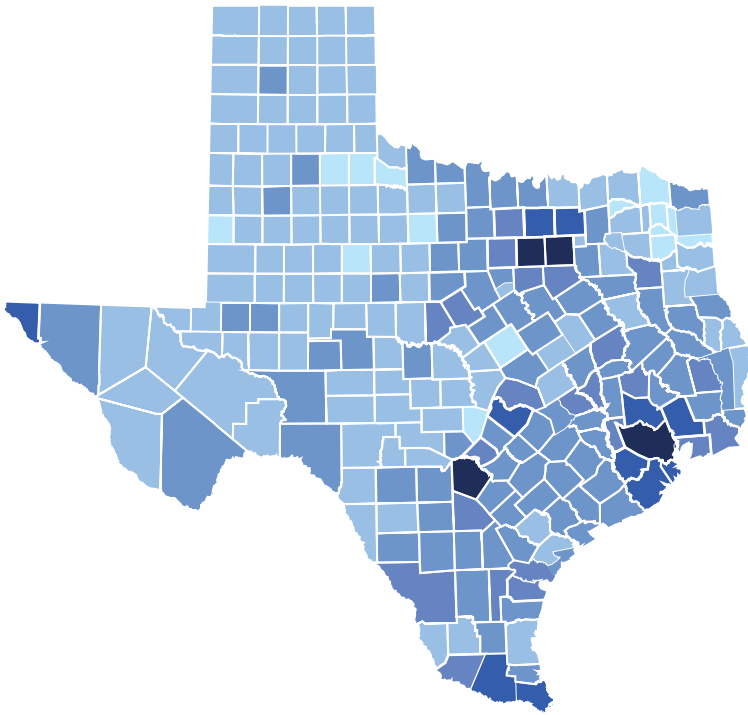
- **36** companies started, expanded, or brought to Texas with CPRIT investment totaling **\$437.1 million**
- CPRIT awards increase venture capital biotech investment in Texas by **11 percent**
- **\$3.08 billion** (greater than 7 to 1) direct follow-on funding raised by CPRIT companies
- **\$1.38 billion** in 2018 total expenditures statewide
- **\$58 million** annual state and local tax collections
- **Over 10,100** permanent jobs created in 2018 in Texas

EXPEDITING INNOVATION BREAKTHROUGHS IN PREVENTION AND CURES

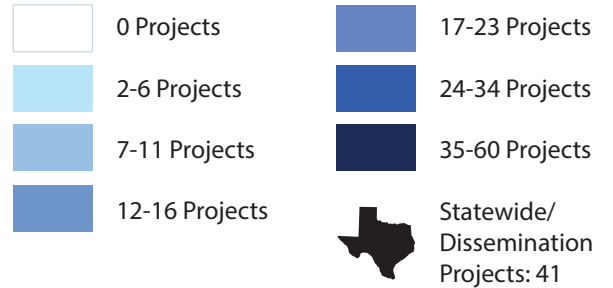
- 19,570 patients in 132 **clinical trials or studies** statewide
- **\$250 million** in grants awarded to 226 prevention programs
- **17,312** cancer precursors and **3,677** cancers detected in Texas
- Nationally recognized teams and centers in immunotherapy and childhood cancers
- **12 percent** of CPRIT's portfolio goes to childhood cancer research – proportionately **3 times** more than national commitment

Follow-on funds (**\$4.18 Billion**) raised by academic research grantees and CPRIT-funded companies (**\$2.16 Billion**), exceeding contracted awards by **\$2.02 Billion**





Delivered 5.7 million prevention services to Texans from all 254 counties



CPRIT has enabled the recruitment of 181 scholars and 13 companies to Texas
