REAL MOMENTUM IN MEASURABLE RESULTS

The Cancer Prevention & Research Institute of Texas was created in 2007 when Texans voted to invest \$3 billion in a historic fight against cancer. Texas voters continued their support in 2019, when they overwhelmingly approved a constitutional amendment to provide an additional \$3 billion, making CPRIT a \$6 billion, 20-year initiative.

CPRIT awards grants for a wide variety of innovative cancer-related research, prevention and product development projects. **Houston-area benefits include:**

Investing in the research capabilities of Houston-area research entities

► \$1.34 billion in grants awarded to 12 Houston-area research entities

► 151 stellar researchers and their labs recruited to Houston-area research entities

► \$1.85 billion in direct follow-on funding raised by Houston-area CPRIT grantees

► Baylor College of Medicine achieved NCI comprehensive cancer center status – joining The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center

► 37 CPRIT core facility awards and renewals in the Houston area to provide access to cutting-edge shared technology through specialized instrumentation and technical expertise

Expand life science infrastructure by attracting companies to Houston & creating high-quality jobs

► 31 companies started, expanded, or brought to the Houston area with CPRIT investment totaling \$352 million

► 32 grants that established connections between companies and Houston-area academic institutions

- \$49.4 million annual state and local tax collections
- ► \$2.7 billion (8 to 1) direct follow-on funding raised by CPRIT companies
- ▶ Over 7,840 permanent jobs created in 2022 in Texas

\$1.21 billion total expenditures statewide in 2022

Expedite innovation breakthroughs in prevention and cures

► 42,049 patients in 157 clinical trials or studies in the Houston area

► \$354 million in grants awarded for 291 prevention projects in all 254 Texas counties

► 34,096 cancer precursors and 5,058 cancers detected in Texas

Follow-on Funding Success

CPRIT-funded academic research grantees and companies in the Houston area raised \$4.59 billion in follow-on funds, exceeding contracted awards by \$3.42 billion


- ► Nationally recognized teams and centers in immunotherapy and childhood cancers
- ► 12 percent of CPRIT's portfolio goes to childhood cancer projects – proportionately 3 times more than national commitment
