REAL MOMENTUM | MEASURABLE RESULTS

The Cancer Prevention & Research Institute of Texas was created in 2007 when Texans voted to invest \$3 billion in a historic fight against cancer. Texas voters continued their support in 2019, when they overwhelmingly approved a constitutional amendment to provide an additional \$3 billion, making CPRIT a \$6 billion, 20-year initiative.

CPRIT awards grants for a wide variety of innovative cancer-related research, prevention and product development projects. **Metroplex-area benefits include:**

Investing in the research capabilities of Metroplex-area research entities

- ► \$630 million in grants awarded to 9 Metroplex-area research entities
- ► 100 stellar researchers and their labs recruited to Metroplex-area research entities
- ► \$690 million in direct follow-on funding raised by Metroplex-area CPRIT grantees
- ► UT Southwestern Medical Center achieved NCI comprehensive cancer center status
- ▶ 10 CPRIT core facility awards and renewals in the Metroplex area to provide access to cutting-edge shared technology through specialized instrumentation and technical expertise

Expand life science infrastructure by attracting companies to the Metroplex & creating high-quality jobs

- ► 10 companies started, expanded, or brought to the Metroplex with CPRIT investment totaling \$95 million
- ► 13 grants to companies with established connections to Texas research institutions
- ► \$1.21 billion total expenditures statewide in 2023
- ▶ \$1.86 billion annual state and local tax receipts
- ► \$2.06 billion direct follow-on funding raised by CPRIT companies in the Metroplex
- ▶ Over 7,377 permanent jobs created in 2023 in Texas


Expedite innovation breakthroughs in prevention and cures

- ► 5,575 patients in 68 clinical trials or studies in the Metroplex
- ▶ \$381 million in grants awarded for 303 prevention projects in all 254 Texas counties
- ► 43,225 cancers and cancer precursors detected by CPRIT-funded prevention projects
- ► Nationally recognized teams and centers in immunotherapy and childhood cancers in Texas
- ► 12 percent of CPRIT's portfolio goes to childhood cancer projects proportionally 3 times greater than federal commitment

Follow-on Funding Success

CPRIT-funded academic research grantees and companies in the Metroplex raised \$2.75 billion in follow-on funds, exceeding contracted awards by \$2.02 billion
