REAL MOMENTUM **IND** MEASURABLE RESULTS

The Cancer Prevention & Research Institute of Texas was created in 2007 when Texans voted to invest \$3 billion in a historic fight against cancer. Texas voters continued their support in 2019, when they overwhelmingly approved a constitutional amendment to provide an additional \$3 billion, making CPRIT a \$6 billion initiative.

CPRIT awards grants for a wide variety of innovative cancer-related research, prevention, and product development projects. **Metroplex-area benefits include:**

Investing in the research capabilities of Metroplex-area research entities

► \$665 million in grants awarded to 9 Metroplex-area research entities

► 105 stellar researchers and their labs recruited to Metroplex-area research entities

- ► \$800 million in direct follow-on funding raised by Metroplex-area CPRIT grantees
- ► UT Southwestern Medical Center achieved NCI comprehensive cancer center status

► 13 CPRIT core facility awards and renewals in the Metroplex area to provide access to cutting-edge shared technology through specialized instrumentation and technical expertise

Expand life science infrastructure by attracting companies to the Metroplex & creating high-quality jobs

► 13 companies started, expanded, or brought to the Metroplex with CPRIT investment totaling \$139 million

► 16 grants to companies with established connections to Texas research institutions

- \$2.15 billion annual state and local tax receipts
- ► \$2.18 billion direct follow-on funding raised by CPRIT companies in the Metroplex
- ▶ Over 7,640 permanent jobs created in 2024 in Texas
- ▶ \$1.29 billion total expenditures statewide in 2024

Expedite innovation breakthroughs in prevention and cures

► 6,424 patients in 72 clinical trials or studies in the Metroplex

► \$394 million in grants awarded for 311 prevention projects in all 254 Texas counties

► 48,431 cancers and cancer precursors detected by CPRIT-funded prevention projects

Follow-on Funding Success

CPRIT-funded academic research grantees and companies in the Metroplex raised \$2.98 billion in follow-on funds, exceeding contracted awards by \$2.19 billion ► Nationally recognized teams and centers in immunotherapy and childhood cancers in Texas


13 percent of CPRIT's portfolio goes to childhood cancer projects – proportionally 3 times greater than federal commitment
