### **REAL MOMENTUM** **MEASURABLE RESULTS**

**T**he Cancer Prevention & Research Institute of Texas was created in 2007 when Texans voted to invest \$3 billion in a historic fight against cancer. Texas voters continued their support in 2019, when they overwhelmingly approved a constitutional amendment to provide an additional \$3 billion, making CPRIT a \$6 billion initiative.

CPRIT awards grants for a wide variety of innovative cancer-related research, prevention and product development projects. Established by the Texas Legislature, our three-fold mission is:

#### **Invest in the research prowess of Texas universities and research organizations**

- ▶ 348 stellar researchers and their labs recruited to Texas research entities
- ▶ Texas achieved 3 NCI comprehensive cancer centers - previously only MD Anderson Cancer Center
- ▶ \$4.26 billion in direct follow-on funding raised by CPRIT research grantees
- ▶ 97 CPRIT core facility awards and renewals to provide access to cutting-edge shared technology through specialized instrumentation and technical expertise

#### **Expand life science infrastructure by attracting companies to Texas & creating high-quality jobs**

- ▶ 78 companies started, expanded, or brought to Texas with CPRIT investment totaling \$852.2 million
- ▶ 86 grants with established connections to Texas academic institutions
- ▶ \$1.38 billion total expenditures generated by CPRIT activities statewide in 2025
- ▶ \$2.57 billion annual state and local tax receipts
- ▶ \$7.79 billion (9 to 1) direct follow-on funding raised by CPRIT-funded companies
- ▶ 8,144 permanent jobs created in 2025 in Texas

#### **Expedite innovation breakthroughs in prevention and cures**

- ▶ 71,233 patients in 432 clinical trials or studies statewide
- ▶ \$434 million in grants awarded for 332 prevention projects in all 254 Texas counties
- ▶ 56,719 cancers and cancer precursors detected by CPRIT-funded prevention projects
- ▶ Nationally recognized teams and centers in immunotherapy and childhood cancers
- ▶ 13 percent of CPRIT's portfolio goes to childhood cancer projects - proportionally 3 times greater than federal commitment

### **Follow-on Funding Success**

CPRIT-funded academic research grantees and companies raised \$12.05 billion in follow-on funds, exceeding contracted awards by \$8.41 billion

CPRIT grants helped deliver 11.5 million prevention services to Texans in all 254 counties

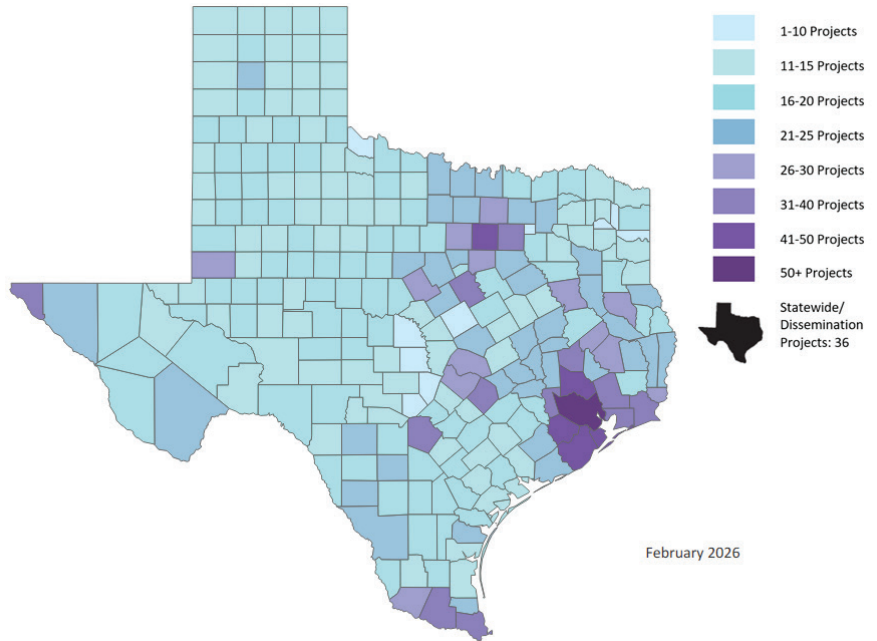

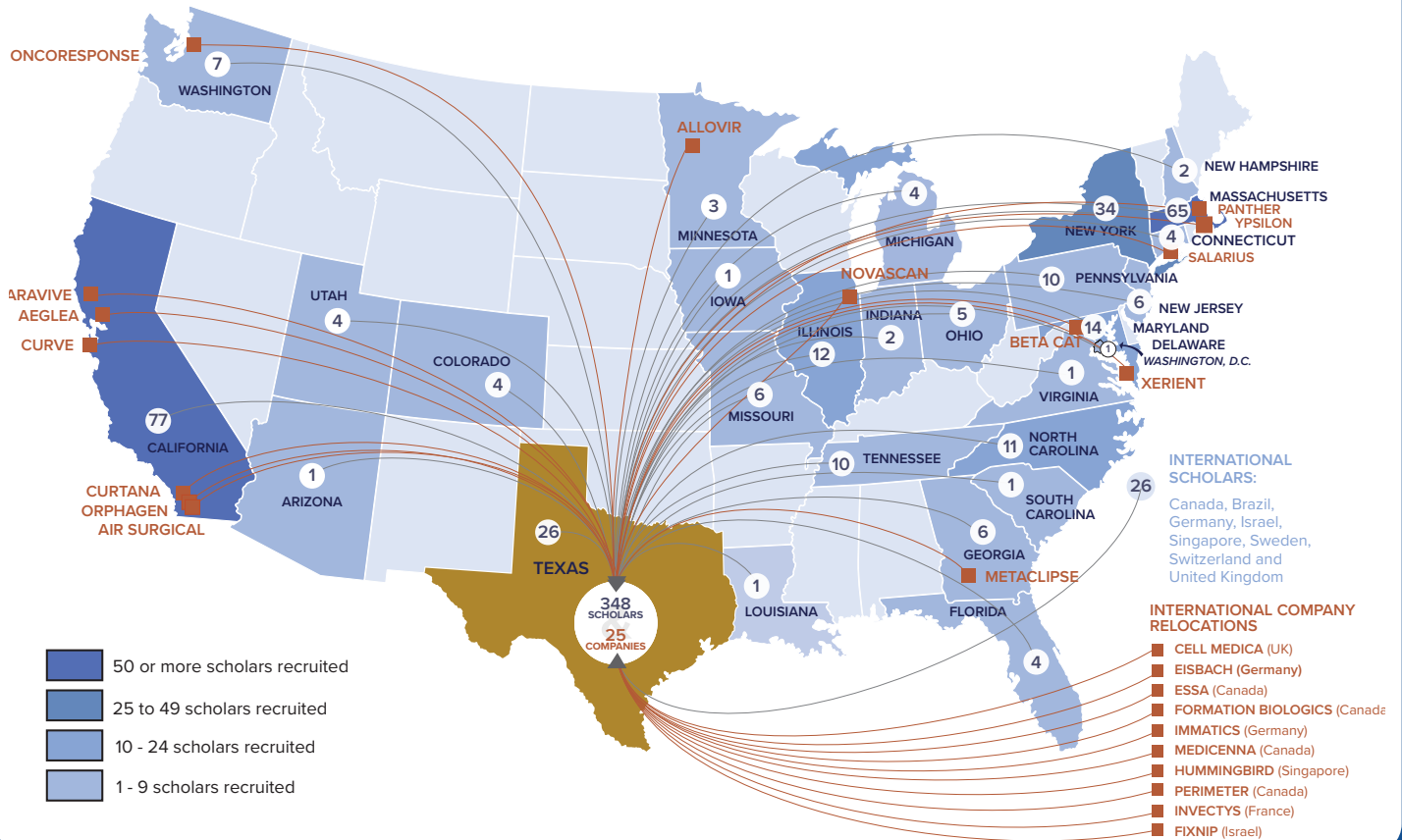
