REAL MOMENTUM **MEASURABLE RESULTS**

The Cancer Prevention & Research Institute of Texas was created in 2007 when Texans voted to invest \$3 billion in a historic fight against cancer. Texas voters continued their support in 2019, when they overwhelmingly approved a constitutional amendment to provide an additional \$3 billion, making CPRIT a \$6 billion initiative.

CPRIT awards grants for a wide variety of innovative cancer-related research, prevention, and product development projects. **Metroplex-area benefits include:**

Investing in the research capabilities of Metroplex-area research entities

- ▶ \$713 million in grants awarded to 9 Metroplex-area research entities
- ▶ 113 stellar researchers and their labs recruited to Metroplex-area research entities
- ▶ \$859 million in direct follow-on funding raised by Metroplex-area CPRIT research grantees
- ▶ UT Southwestern Medical Center achieved NCI comprehensive cancer center status
- ▶ 16 CPRIT core facility awards and renewals in the Metroplex area to provide access to cutting-edge shared technology through specialized instrumentation and technical expertise

Expand life science infrastructure by attracting companies to the Metroplex & creating high-quality jobs

- ▶ 11 companies started, expanded, or brought to the Metroplex with CPRIT investment totaling \$113 million
- ▶ 16 grants to companies with established connections to Texas research institutions
- ▶ \$1.38 billion total expenditures statewide in 2025
- ▶ \$2.57 billion annual state and local tax receipts
- ▶ \$2.23 billion direct follow-on funding raised by CPRIT-funded companies in the Metroplex
- ▶ 8,144 permanent jobs created in 2025 in Texas

Expedite innovation breakthroughs in prevention and cures across Texas

- ▶ 11,260 patients in 132 clinical trials or studies in Metroplex area
- ▶ \$434 million in grants awarded for 332 prevention projects in all 254 Texas counties
- ▶ 58,507 cancers and cancer precursors detected by CPRIT-funded prevention projects
- ▶ Nationally recognized teams and centers in immunotherapy and childhood cancers in Texas
- ▶ 13 percent of CPRIT's portfolio goes to childhood cancer projects—a significant commitment helping drive meaningful research advances

Follow-on Funding Success

CPRIT-funded academic research grantees and companies in the Metroplex raised \$3.09 billion in follow-on funds, exceeding contracted awards by \$2.264 billion

CPRIT grants helped deliver 11.8 million prevention services to Texans in all 254 counties

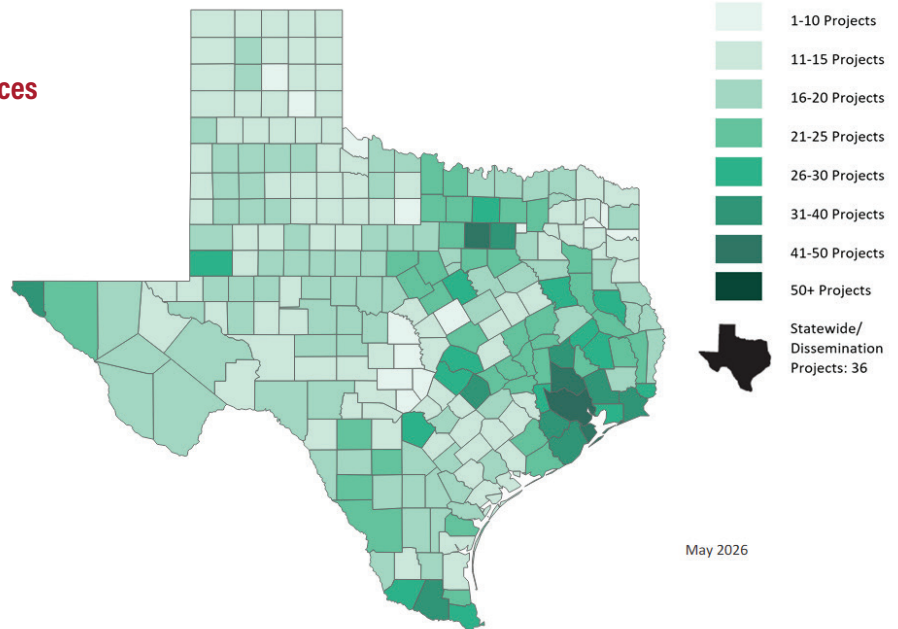

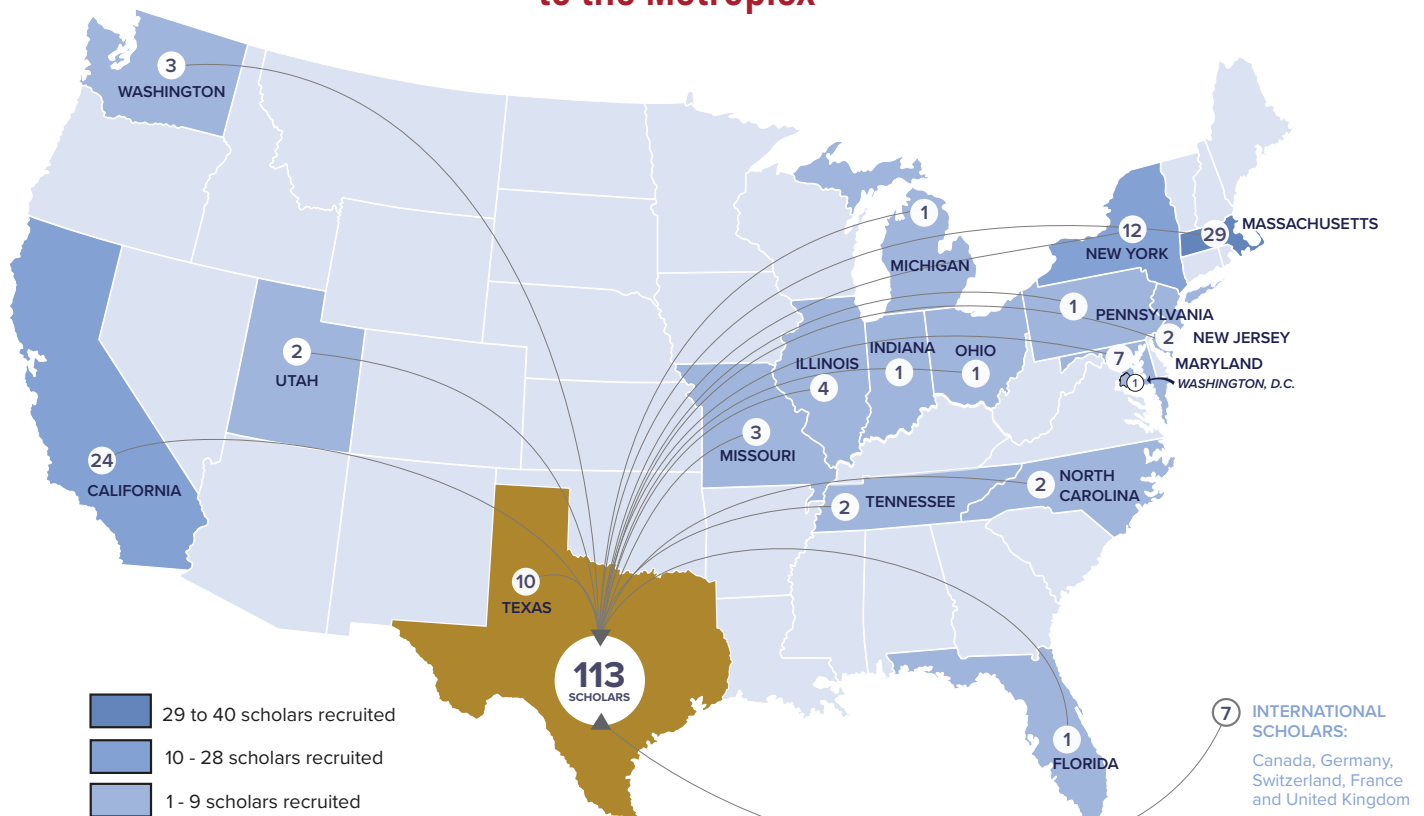
