REAL MOMENTUM  **MEASURABLE RESULTS**

The Cancer Prevention & Research Institute of Texas was created in 2007 when Texans voted to invest \$3 billion in a historic fight against cancer. Texas voters continued their support in 2019, when they overwhelmingly approved a constitutional amendment to provide an additional \$3 billion, making CPRIT a \$6 billion, 20-year initiative.

CPRIT awards grants for a wide variety of innovative cancer-related research, prevention and product development projects. **Metroplex-area benefits include:**

Investing in the research capabilities of Metroplex-area research entities

- ▶ \$606 million in grants awarded to 6 Metroplex-area research entities
- ▶ 93 stellar researchers and their labs recruited to Metroplex-area research entities
- ▶ \$598 million in direct follow-on funding raised by Metroplex-area CPRIT grantees
- ▶ UT Southwestern Medical Center achieved NCI comprehensive cancer center status
- ▶ 10 CPRIT core facility awards and renewals in the Metroplex area to provide access to cutting-edge shared technology through specialized instrumentation and technical expertise

Expand life science infrastructure by attracting companies to the Metroplex & creating high-quality jobs

- ▶ 8 companies started, expanded, or brought to the Metroplex with CPRIT investment totaling \$82.6 million
- ▶ 8 CPRIT-funded companies have established connections to Metroplex-area academic institutions
- ▶ \$1.34 billion total expenditures statewide in 2021
- ▶ \$55.4 million annual state and local tax collections
- ▶ \$1.2 billion direct follow-on funding raised by CPRIT companies in the Metroplex
- ▶ Over 9,228 permanent jobs created in 2021 in Texas

Expedite innovation breakthroughs in prevention and cures

- ▶ 1,668 patients in 30 clinical trials or studies in the Metroplex
- ▶ \$327 million in grants awarded for 274 prevention projects in all 254 Texas counties
- ▶ 28,206 cancer precursors and 4,653 cancers detected in Texas
- ▶ Nationally recognized teams and centers in immunotherapy and childhood cancers in Texas
- ▶ 11 percent of CPRIT's portfolio goes to childhood cancer projects - proportionately 3 times more than national commitment

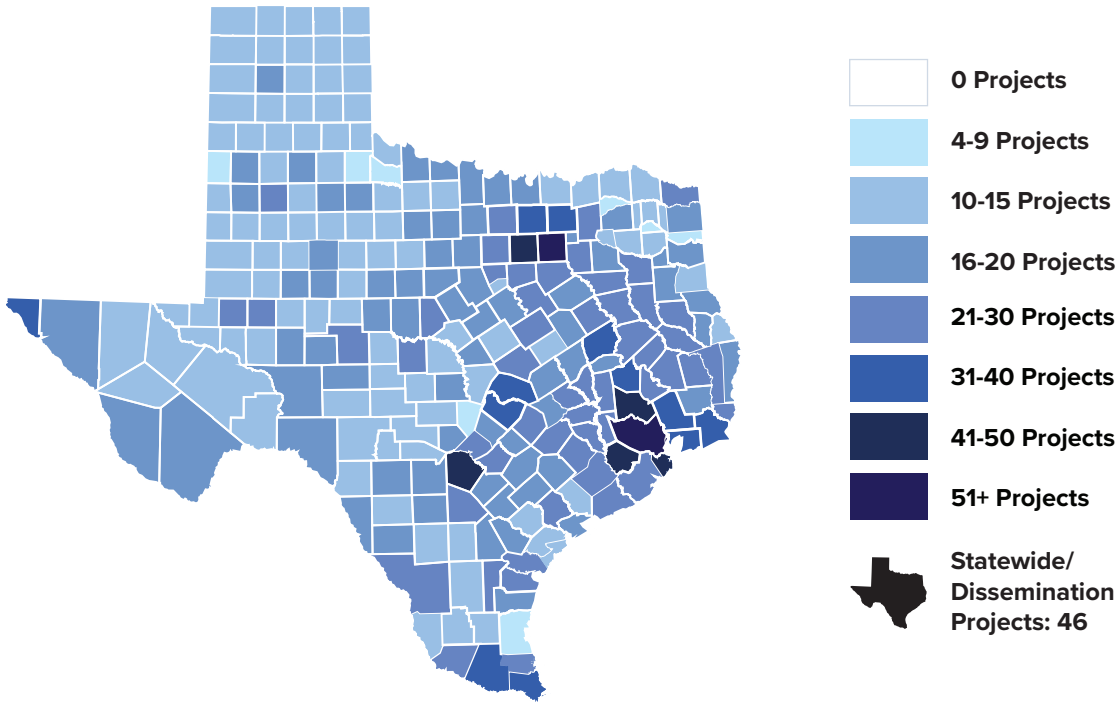
Follow-on Funding Success

CPRIT-funded academic research grantees and companies in the Metroplex raised \$1.83 billion in follow-on funds, exceeding contracted awards by \$1.14 billion



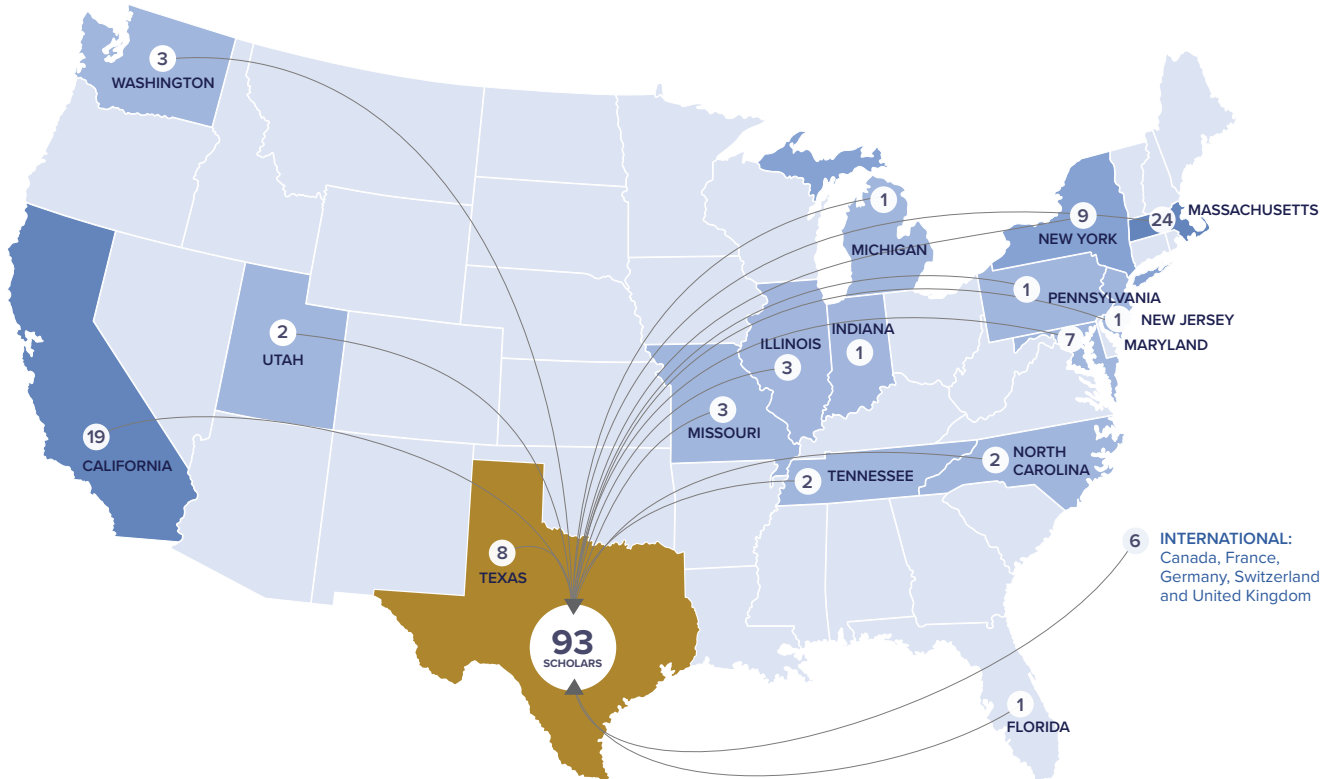
Prevention Services
